ENTRY FEE

The cost is \$15 per submission. (3 Submissions Maximum.) AI submissions are NOT permitted. Acceptable payment methods are cash, check payable to Tioga Arts Council, and credit card.

SALES

All artwork must be for sale, and a 20% commission will be taken on all sales. The commission will support TAC's Beyond the Gallery programs, such as Art a la Carte, which brings arts-enrichment activities to children and families who utilize summer meal sites in Tioga County.

Everyday Life, Every Day Art Award Categories

BEST IN SHOW

PAINTING

Watercolor, tempera, oils, acrylics on a two-dimensional surface.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Digital and traditional, altered and unaltered.

SCULPTURE

Three-dimensional art made by various material and processes: carving, modelling, casting, and constructing.

FIBER

Material consists of natural or synthetic fiber, and other components, such as fabric or yarn.

CERAMICS

Functional and non-functional clay works.

MIXED MEDIA 2D & 3D

- COLLAGE 2D artworks composed from a combination of different media or materials.
- ASSEMBLAGE 3D artworks constructed from a combination of different media or materials.

PRINTMAKING

Transferring images through woodcut, etching, engraving, and lithography to another surface. Works should be from a limited run (under 50).

DRAWING & ILLUSTRATION

Pencil, ink, graphite, charcoal, pastels, and markers created on a two-dimensional surface.

TRADITIONAL FINE CRAFT

Original designed woodworking, jewelry, metal work and stained-glass.

NOTE: If you are unsure of which category, you should list an artwork, we will give assistance at drop off at Cloud Croft Studios, 1003 Sanford Rd., Owego, NY on August 2, 3, 4 between 12 – 4 p.m.

Everyday Life, Every Day Art Submission Requirements

- Open to all artists within 100-mile radius of Owego, NY.
- This is a live jurying event. Artists can submit a digital entry form or a paper one. (Digital is encouraged.) All media outlined above will be accepted for adjudication and exhibition. (Electronic artwork images are for promotional purposes, including building a catalogue. It is not used in the adjudication process.)
- Maximum number of submissions is three (3) per artist.
- All work must be original.
- All work must be for sale.
- AI-generated artwork is not permitted.
- Two-dimensional (2D) submissions may NOT exceed 60" in the longest dimension. It MUST BE PROPERLY WIRED for hanging.
- Three-dimensional work should weigh no more than 100 lbs. Please contact Cloud Croft Studios if your work requires a pedestal.
- All artists will be asked to sign a waiver relinquishing Cloud Croft Studios, Tioga Arts Council, and any other involved parties of responsibility for damage or theft of work.
- Artists must be at least 18 years of age.
- All submissions will be juried from the original for quality, content, and space.
- Work must not have been shown in ELEDA previously.
- All participants must adhere to the pick-up and drop-off dates outlined in the call.
- All artists must complete and submit:
 - ✓ Complete an Entry Form
 - ✓ Sign a Waiver & Release (Both in advance and/or drop off.)
 - ✓ Make Payment
 - ✓ Adhere to Deadlines

I release Cloud Croft Studios and Tioga Arts Council its staff, Board of Directors, members, employees, volunteers, partners, sponsors, and agents free and harmless from any loss, or damage that may happen to my art, or resulting cost or liability during the time that my art is shipped to, from, and during the stay at Cloud Croft Studios.
